## Notes

1. The tracks are set up as suggested guides for participants with various needs. They are not required; individuals are free to choose as they like. The following courses, however, are required for students in Field Training, unless they have had equivalent training elsewhere:
  - a. Audio A or Audio B (recording techniques and manipulation of digital audio files)
  - b. Data Management
  - c. Field Phonetics

People who have questions about whether particular workshops are appropriate to their needs should contact the organizers.

2. The “lettered” workshops (e.g. Orthography A, Orthography B) represent more than one offering of the same workshop: choose one.
3. There are two plenary workshops, for all participants: “Steps in language documentation” and “Models of language documentation and revitalization”.
  - a. “Steps” will be offered in two sessions on June 23<sup>rd</sup>, plus participants should attend one of the offerings of the third session “Steps 3” in the computer labs.
  - b. “Models” will be daily after lunch and will constitute a series of lectures by practitioners of language documentation and revitalization
4. “Life in the field” sessions are independent of each other and can be taken individually. All other workshops contain structured curricula and participants should plan to attend all sessions
5. During “Open lab” hours, students are welcome to come to the Life Sciences Computing Facility to work on projects. Meetings with instructors can also be easily arranged, at the computer labs or at an on-campus office, as required.
