Note: Students are encouraged to take a language outside the Indo-European family. Native speakers of languages other than English may petition to count either English or their native language as fulfilling the language requirement.

UPPER-DIVISION MAJOR

Before beginning the upper-division major, students are advised to consult the department regarding the scheduling of required courses.

Note: All Language and Speech Technology courses except Linguistics 102 have prerequisites and must be taken in order. Most courses have Linguistics 102 as a prerequisite, so it should be taken as early as possible. One advanced two-course sequence (Linguistics 104 & 105 OR Linguistics 110 & 111 OR Linguistics 110 & 119) must be completed. Because of the prerequisite structure, it must be completed in order.
